### STATE RESULTS FOR TAS



Chelsea Whelan from Tasmania was appointed as our brand ambassador.

Chelsea is the first woman in Tasmania to take on and complete her bricklaying apprenticeship, Chelsea decided to follow in her father and grandfather's footsteps, both were bricklayers.

- Strong growth in numbers continues in Tasmania with total bricklaying apprentices supported by Brick and Block Careers increasing by more than 35%, compared with the same time last year.
- Several Step Out in Bricks programs are planned for secondary school students and will be conducted at TasTAFE with funding from Keystone.
- The Tas team have also been building relationships virtually, including promoting women in trades.
- Building our engagement with TasTAFE and new employers across the State and assisting with filling apprenticeship vacancies as they are identified.
